## COVID Protocols Update

September 19, 2022

Dear Cyber Village Academy Community,

As we enter the 2022/2023 School Year, we've updated our COVID protocols and will continue to closely monitor the risk levels of our state, county, and local hospitals while very closely watching our internal school COVID numbers.

Effective Immediately:

- We ask that families do wellness checks prior to entering our building.
- Our school communities will follow their posted Illness Policies; when children have symptoms of COVID or other illness we ask that they stay home until symptoms have resolved.
- It is important that if your student has COVID symptoms, take a test and report only positive results to [Nicole Rasmussen](#) and/or [Nick Rice](#) immediately.
- Anyone testing positive for COVID will still be required to isolate for 5 days (from the date of the positive test or the first onset of symptoms) and then may return to campus with a mask for the next 5 days. Children who cannot mask must isolate for 10 days before returning to school.
- Siblings of a student who tests positive should continue to attend school if they are symptom free.
- An email notice will go out to the class if someone in your students' grade or class tests positive for COVID, so that you can monitor your child for any symptoms and test if necessary.
- Masks are welcome everywhere but will remain optional.
- Each classroom has cleaning supplies that can be used throughout the day.
- As always, all our procedures are kept under review.
