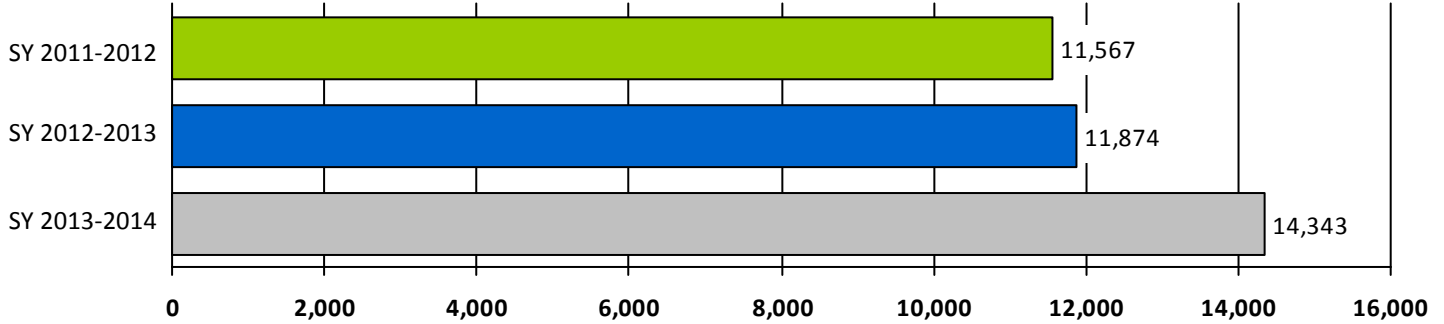

Note: Includes all enrolled homeless children and youth in grades PK through 12.

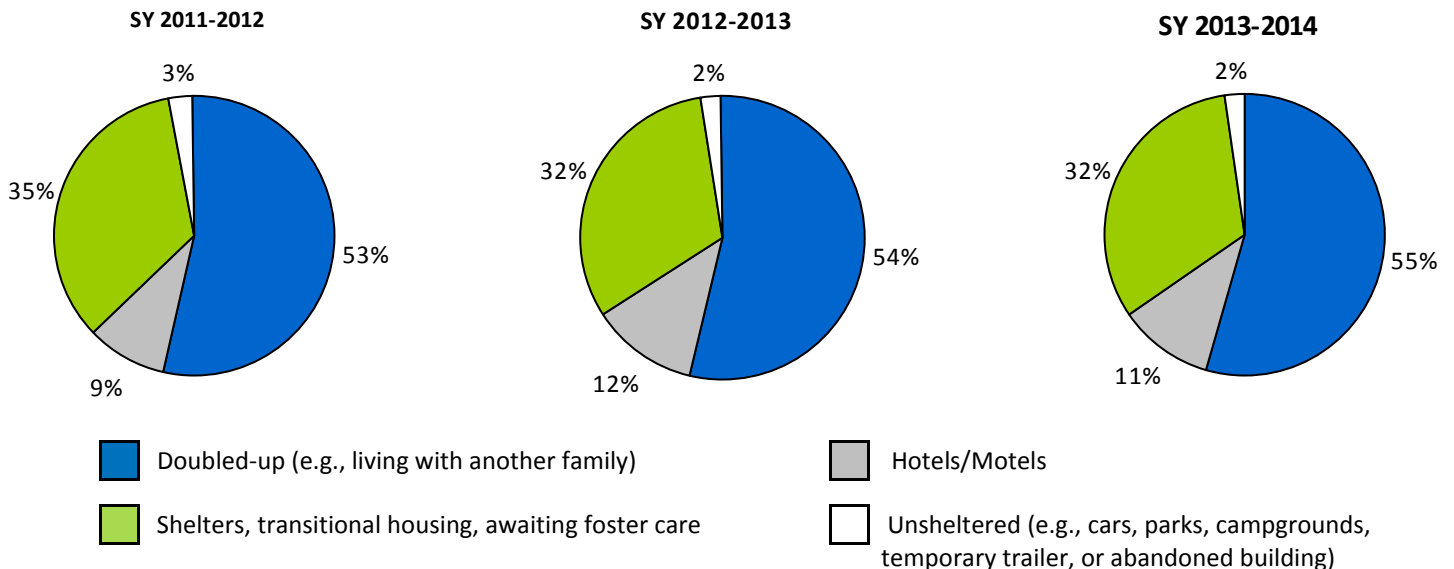
**Subgroups of Homeless Children/Youth**

Limited English Proficient (LEP) students	1,330	1,477
